



COROMANDEL CRICKET CLUB

2025/26 Selection Policy

Selection at the Coromandel Cricket Club will be made *on balance* around the following Selection Criteria:

1. TRAINING ATTENDANCE:

Senior training is every Thursday from 5:30pm to dark. We value those who come to training and actively make the effort to improve their own game but also our teammates' games too.

2. FINANCIAL STATUS:

Priority will be given to players who have met their financial obligations to the club, meaning fees are paid or are up to date with any payment plans.

3. GAME PERFORMANCE:

Contributions to the team's performance in scoring runs, taking wickets and playing a team role. Additional to statistics, is the value a player brings to the team game, improving the environment around them and making the team and club a better place to play cricket.

4. CLUB EVENTS:

Our players are encouraged to attend club events (Presentations and other dedicated events) whenever possible. If you cannot attend, please advise the Events committee.

Additional points around selection:

TRAINING ABSENCES

Players need to notify their grade Captain if they are unable to attend training. This applies for preseason as well. If we know numbers prior to training, we can manage training more effectively so everyone gets more out of the session.

WORK AND FAMILY ACCOMMODATIONS

The club understands varying work commitments and the importance of family as a priority. Captains ask for proactive communication around this to help plan team selections early in the week.

PRIORITY FOR FINANCIAL PLAYERS

This ensures the financial stability and fairness within the club.

AFTER MATCH PRESENTATIONS

Attending club events and presentations where possible is encouraged to continue to build the club to be in a healthy position culturally and to share in everyone's success.

TWO DAY GAMES

Preference for game selection will *usually* be given to players who can commit to both days of a match. In cases where a "slash" player (playing only one day) is deemed suitable, they may be considered, but this will be at the discretion of the captains, on balance with the Selection Criteria.

JUNIOR AVAILABILITY

In a circumstance where a Junior player and a Senior player both meet all criteria equally, selection priority will be given to the Senior.

MEMBER VALUE

The club values its members and players, emphasising the importance of participation and camaraderie. The Committee and Captains value and prioritise communication and will endeavour to communicate with our members around selection. The Committee and Captains welcome and encourage open and honest proactive communication and dialogue around selection, and want what is best in the long term for our members.

Our club is nothing without its dedicated members and players. By adhering to this selection policy, we aim to foster a committed and cohesive team environment that upholds the values of the Coromandel Cricket Club. When selections are made, they will be made with the above selection criteria as guiding principles.
